The One Flutter program is an opportunity for team members to support a cause of their choice in a variety of ways. Day of Change offers up to 8 hours a year of paid time off for volunteering and Adjoin provides a \$25 reimbursement for donations made to a nonprofit. Each team member can be a catalyst for change - One Flutter at a time.

Following my retirement in education, I was looking for something that would be rewarding and allow me to give back to the community. I was only planning on working part time for a couple of years, but here I am, 18 years later, still enjoying my time with Adjoin.

The One Flutter program is just one of many I am thankful for. I have made 3 trips to Arizona to deliver animals to shelters: twice I took a camper full of dogs and cats from the streets of Tijuana to Casa Grande, and an SUV full of hedgehogs and a rabbit to Buckeye. Most recently I helped transport a couple of pigs rescued from a research lab in Northern California to a sanctuary in Jacumba.



Dear Ms. Forkas:

As the CEO, I think it's important for you to know how successful your Adjoin Veterans program is, and the individuals who make that possible.

Last year, my life was spinning out of control. I was going through a divorce without any support and my disabled daughter lost her father to a heart attack who, also a retired military veteran, was a huge emotional and financial support for her. The sudden weight of these full responsibilities came at a time when I couldn't find work due to my own disabilities. This caused my health to decline and I was in jeopardy of being homeless. Courage to Call referred me to Adjoin and from the moment I was accepted, I was treated with the utmost respect!

San Diego is the most expensive city in the nation and has been my home for 34 years. This program not only saved me, but saved my adult children and granddaughter in countless ways. It is my hope that I find part-time employment that is a good fit for my disabilities. Adjoin has also given me the confidence to possibly open my own business. I have come a long way and have Adjoin to thank for this progress.





Where Takes Flight



financial overview

Financially, Adjoin achieved record revenues of \$29.7 million in FY2024, a \$7.6 million or 34% increase year-over-year. On a proforma basis—adjusting for favorable investment gains and one-time legal settlement expenses—we achieved a positive operating income of \$24,000, a significant turnaround from the prior year's loss of (\$902,000). This underscores the positive impact of our organizational changes and strategic investments.

Operationally, enhancements to internal controls and procedures were a major focus, particularly around our Setworks timekeeping and client management system, which integrates directly with payroll and accounting. We advanced our UKG HRIS/Payroll implementation, launched the Zeffy donation platform, and refreshed our fleet by replacing 12 vehicles. Adjoin continued investing in strategic initiatives such as Path-Now and InFlight.



Revenue by Division


