Meet Kelli,

Kelli is an honorably discharged Navy veteran who contacted Adjoin's San Diego Veteran Services program in June 2020. Kelli was living in an RV without services and was deemed uninhabitable and was enrolled in our SSVF rapid re-housing program. Kelli is a Registered Nurse, however, was unemployed when she was enrolled. Once enrolled, she was connected to a Housing Coordinator and Case Coordinator and was housed in permanent housing within 60 days of enrollment. Kelly has endured a lot of challenges in her life, and at times during her enrollment, and it was discussed that working directly with a Supervisor, Adriana A., for case management services would be the best plan to meet her needs. Kelli also had some outstanding recertification courses to complete for her nursing license reinstatement and was connected to a local Homeless Veterans Reintegration Program (HVRP). After completing many courses, trainings and recertifications, in January 2022 Kelli's RN license was reinstated! Shortly after that, Kelli received a job offer! As of May 2022, Kelli will be transitioning to our shallow subsidy program, where she will pay 50% of rent and Adjoin will pay 50% and receive light case management services, while she continues to work on paying off debt, saving, and eventually attaining her goal of purchasing her first home using a VA home loan!
