

Path-Now is an accessible mobile app by Adjoin that connects individuals with IDD and autism to service providers electronically across California. With tools for service navigation and a dedicated careers section, it's a trusted hub for building a more connected, inclusive, and efficient disability community.

Veteran Career Opportunities

Veteran households receive case management services including referrals to, America's Job Centers, employment opportunities, peer support resume/LinkedIn profile development, and other referrals to find meaningful employment. In addition, our benefits coordinator provides an assessment of potentially eligible veteran benefits the household may qualify for.

Veteran households are connected to referrals and services based upon a needs assessment. Our health care coordinator assists eligible Veterans to connect to the local VA. Ineligible veterans and household members are connected to community resources as needed.

Self Determination Program









The Self-Determination Program empowers Regional Center clients to design and choose support services based on their person-centered plan. It allows for flexible services from vendorized or non-vendorized providers, with individuals responsible for budgeting and managing their paid support network.

Independent Living Services



Catalysts offers assistance and training to help clients with the skills necessary to have one's own home or apartment with minimal assistance to be as fully self-sufficient as possible. The process begins by increasing self-reliance by means of providing a balance of support, counseling, and training in the home.

Supported Living Services



In the Supported Living program, a client may live alone or with a roommate, neighbor, or other support person, as preferred. Clients receive enhanced care in the SLS program including medication management, personal care support, and other specialized services.

An innovative online skills training program, Inflight Skills Academy, teaches independent living, vocational, and social skills to individuals with IDD and autism. Adjoin is offering this unique post-secondary programming designed with neurodiverse learners in mind but open to all learners! This program is open to all private pay individuals, Self-Determination clients, as well as San Diego Regional Center and Valley Mountain Regional Center clients in the State of California.

Online



Self-paced AND live on Zoom! Enjoy activities, simulations, and games in your interactive online classroom and interact with the teacher and classmates in live online seminars each week.

Accessible



Designed with neurodiverse learners in mind, each course features closed captioning, click to listen, speech to text, audio, visual, recorded seminars, multi-modal assignments, and more!

Independent



Take class anywhere, anytime! You'll need a device, such as a computer, tablet, or smartphone; reliable internet access; and about 4 hours per week.

Creative Arts



Arte is a 24-mo program designed to develop the creative arts interests and skills of people with IDD. Arte offers skill development in a variety of creative arts media and entrepreneurship skill building around the marketing, discussion, and sale of one's art.

Social Rec



Social recreation is an addendum for individuals with recreational interest in art. The program is built to support the interests of those who work or attend program but would like additional opportunity for recreation and connection around art.

At its core, the Catalyst Social Club is about offering meaningful opportunities for clients to explore their interests, build friendships, and enjoy life outside of traditional service settings.

Adjoin invests unbillable staff time to assist clients through the process of coordinating and attending activities. This program is free for clients but some activities may have a share of cost component.

Adjoin's One Flutter team member program was launched in July 2020 and was inspired by the voices of our team members. The One Flutter program is based on the "Butterfly Effect", where a small change in a community can result in significant positive changes to society.

We believe every team member can be the change they want to see in the world – One Flutter – at a time. Through the One Flutter program, team members can support a cause close to their hearts each year through a Day of Change. Team members choosing to participate receive up to 8 hours of paid time off to volunteer in their community. Also, all team members are eligible for a reimbursement of \$25 for donating \$25 or more to a cause of their choice each year.
